Thanks to the M&M Area Community Foundation, with funding from the C.S. Mott Foundation Clean Energy Initiative, the School District of Crivitz received a \$3,500 donation to install variable frequency drives and CO2 sensing equipment on the air handling units in the Elementary/Middle School gymnasium and cafeteria. This will significantly reduce energy consumption and allow for better air quality in these high traffic areas. The School District also received \$1,364 in Focus on Energy incentives for this project further reducing the overall cost. Funding from the Community Foundation also helps provide opportunities for teachers to receive professional development in Energy Education. Teachers learn how to integrate clean energy curriculum appropriately in the current science coursework. Students work with hands-on projects that provide experiences with recycling, reuse, and reduction in waste.
