MENOMINEE, MI – The M&M Area Community Foundation, in partnership with inVenture North Inc., a community-based economic development organization, will host leadership training for community members of Marinette and Menominee Counties. Each of the three sessions will be held from 9am – noon on Thursdays: March 5th, March 19th and April 2nd.
