## **SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE FROM M&M AREA COMMUNITY FOUNDATION**

Menominee, MI – The M&M Area Community Foundation (MMACF) thrives on making education more accessible for our community’s youth. In 2019, the MMACF awarded over 65 scholarships totaling nearly \$105,000. Scholarships are available for high school, as well as non-traditional, students throughout Marinette and Menominee Counties.

### **High School Students**

### **Non-Traditional Students**

Non-traditional students are the focus of two of the scholarships offered by the Community Foundation. The “Sara Murray Lambrecht Scholarship for Promising Young Women” was established in 2005 by Laura Cunningham and Mari Hoskins, Sara’s daughters. Women, aged 30 or younger attending or planning to attend a four-year college or university are encouraged to apply. The second scholarship for non-traditional students was established by the sons of Hugh and Mary Higley. Financial need is a principal criterion for the Hugh and Mary Higley Non-Traditional Scholarship and the award must be used for tuition at a two-year or four-year higher education institution.
