SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE FROM M&M AREA COMMUNITY FOUNDATION

MENOMINEE, MI – The M&M Area Community Foundation (MMACF) continues to help make education more accessible for youth across Marinette and Menominee Counties by providing significant funding through scholarships. This year 4 new scholarship funds have been established at the Foundation by community members interested in giving back.

High School Students

Non-Traditional Students

Non-traditional students are the focus of several opportunities offered by the MMACF. The “Sara Murray Lambrecht Scholarship for Promising Young Women” was established in 2005 by Sara’s daughters Laura Cunningham and Mari Hoskins. Women, aged 30 or younger, attending or planning to attend a four-year college are encouraged to apply. A scholarship for non-traditional students was established by the sons of Hugh and Mary Higley. Financial need is a principal criterion for the Hugh and Mary Higley Non-Traditional Scholarship and the award must be used for tuition at a two-year or four-year higher education institution. The E.W. and Dorothy Granskog Memorial Fund was established to promote sustainable organic agriculture in Menominee county. Community members may apply for funds to be used for agriculture related scholarships as well as workshops and programs with a particular emphasis on sustainable organic ag.
